



LAYB Batting Cage Rules

The following procedures must be followed in order to maintain Batting Cage privileges:

- 1) Batting cages are open for use before and during scheduled games. Teams scheduled to use the cages have first priority (see scheduling below).
- 2) Only one batter at a time may be in the cage. Helmets mandatory.
- 3) Do not use the cages without the pitcher's protective screen for the pitcher/machine and a backstop in place (hanging rubber mat).
- 4) No soft toss against batting cage fencing (whiffles OK).
- 5) No climbing on the batting cage.
- 6) No metal cleats!

Scheduling

Cages are designated to be used only by Pinto, Mustang and Bronco teams.
Cage #1 is farthest from the Back field (for Front field scheduled teams).
Cage #2 is closest to the Back field (for Back field scheduled teams).

Use of the cages will be as follows:

All days: Cages will be reserved for use by teams during the game scheduled immediately prior to their scheduled game, even if it is a preceding day. Visiting teams will use the cages during the 1st hour of the game, Home teams will use the cages during the 2nd hour of the game.

Weekdays and 1st Weekend game: Cages will be open 1 hour before game time for use by teams about to play (coach pitch only). Each team will get 20 minutes in the cage with the Home team starting 1 hour before game time, and the Visiting team starting 40 minutes before game time. Both teams should be out of the cages 15 minutes prior to game time for on field warm-up, and to allow the pitching machines to be set up by teams using the cages during the game.
