

LAYB CODE OF CONDUCT

The Los Alamitos Youth Baseball Fields are a fan friendly environment. We encourage you to ENJOY the game. POSITIVE support for our players, coaches and umpires is expected at all times. Be RESPECTFUL. Set a GREAT example and have FUN!

LOCAL PROPERTY RULES

Los Alamitos Youth Baseball is officially located on the Joint Forces Training Base (JFTB), an active military base. The JFTB has generously supported our baseball league for more than 40 years. In return, LAYB has incorporated very specific rules about conduct and behavior on LAYB property.

The following rules apply to all persons attending the LAYB property for any reason:

1. Animals, regardless of size or leash, are prohibited from LAYB property.
2. The use of tobacco in any form is prohibited on LAYB fields or common areas. The only designated area for smoking is the parking lot.
3. Alcoholic beverages of any kind are forbidden on LAYB property.
4. Sunflower seeds are not allowed on LAYB property.
5. Bicycles, Rollerblades, Skates, Scooters and Skateboards are NOT allowed on LAYB property.
6. Please help keep the fields clean by using the trash cans provided. This needs to be done after every game. If a team snack is pizza, please dispose of the pizza boxes in the large trash bins along the 3rd base line of the Mustang field (in the parking lot) Please do not throw or lay them in or on top of the smaller trash cans.
7. Please clean up the tables after team snacks. Return ketchup and mustard to the snack shack and dispose of all trash.
8. No handball against any wooden structure at LAYB. Balls bouncing against these structures cause major paint and structural damage.
9. No parking in front of the large trash bins located on the 3rd base line of the Mustang field. Any car parking there will be towed.
10. Please observe the No Parking and Designated Parking signs in the parking lot.
11. The curbs on Avenue of the Americas have been painted red. This is an official no parking zone and all cars may be cited by the Los Alamitos Police Department.
